Jesus is born

4. THE PRESENTATION – LK 2:22-40

Jesus is presented in the Temple

5. THE FINDING IN THE TEMPLE – LK 2:41-52


Jesus was lost, then Mary & Joseph found him in the temple, teaching about God.
