


In the Lord’s Prayer, we praise and glorify God and petition for what we need. There are 7 petitions in the Lord’s Prayer:

Petitions to God and to draw us to Him for his own sake:

1. Thy Name
2. Thy Kingdom
3. Thy Will

Petitions for us and our needs that God fulfills:

4. Give Us
5. Forgive Us
6. Lead Us Not
7. Deliver Us
